We are to live with such strong hope that it will be attractive to others.

But even if you suffer for doing what is right, God will reward you for it. So don't worry or be afraid of their threats. Instead, you must worship Christ as Lord of your life. And is someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it. But do this in a gentle and respectful way." (1 Peter 3:14-16)

Go and get your husband, Jesus told her. I don't have a husband, the woman replied. Jesus said, "You're right! You don't have a husband for you have had five husbands, and you aren't even married to the man you're living with now. You certainly spoke the truth! (John 4:16-18) NLT

Jesus came to earth:

Reason 3 - To forgive!

Many Samaritans from the village believed in Jesus because the woman had said, "He told me everything I ever did!" When they came out to see him, they begged him to stay in their village. So he stayed for two days, long enough for many more to hear his message and believe. (John 4:39 – 42) NLT

Dear friends, never take revenge. Leave that to the righteous anger of God. For the Scriptures say, I will take revenge; I will pay them back, says the Lord. Instead, If your enemies are hungry, feed them. If they are thirsty, give them something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals of shame on their heads. (Romans 12:19, 20) NLT
